POSITION:	Apiculture and Honey Specialist
ASSIGNMENT LOCATION:	Montrouis or Limbé
ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION:	<p>The specialist will work with local partners who are interested in starting beekeeping activities in communities within the DEED project areas. S/he will assist the associations to improve their management including production and processing of honey. Areas of support to be provided are hive design, hive management, sustainable honey harvesting, honey production calendars (per flowering source). The objective of this assignment is to train beekeepers and beekeeping association leaders in the technical aspects of successful beekeeping, honey production and processing.</p>
QUALIFICATIONS:	<p>The specialist is expected to have a demonstrated solid experience in beekeeping and honey processing at levels that include individual beekeepers as well as in the operation of beekeeping/honey production associations and/or cooperatives.</p>
OTHER REQUIREMENTS:	<p>Qualified persons are expected to be able to communicate with local Haitian partners in either Creole. Previous experience living and working in a developing country context is strongly desired. A valid passport is required for travel to Haiti.</p>
DURATION OF ASSIGNMENT:	<p>One week (Leave for Haiti on Sunday and return home on the following Saturday). The assignment may be extended to two weeks at the request of the specialist. It should be noted that the specialist can choose to extend their stay in Haiti but at their own cost.</p>
