POSITION:	Freshwater Fish Farming Specialist
ASSIGNMENT LOCATION:	Limbé
ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION:	<p>The specialist will work primarily with the producer group APWOLEM in Marmelade and an existing group of 12 fish farmers with one pond each and another 12 fish farmers in the process of site selection prior to pond construction. The expert will assist APWOLEM with pond management, feeding, harvesting, preservation and marketing techniques for the existing ponds. S/he will also work with the new groups of farmers in site selection, pond placement, construction, and fingerling stocking. The person will work closely with DEED field staff based in Marmelade as well as other DEED technical staff. The assistance will also include site visits to other sites in Souffrière, Camp Coq and Limbé to assess the potential fish farming activities. At the end of the assignment, the specialist will prepare an assignment report to be submitted to NOAH.</p>
QUALIFICATIONS:	<p>The specialist is expected to have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A demonstrated solid experience in small scale fish farming with appropriate technology management techniques for rural producers.• Knowledge of fish species specifically appropriate for farming in the Haitian context.• Fluency or adequate working knowledge of Creole and/or French.• Previous experience living and working in a developing country context is strongly desired.• Good personal skills with ability to work with technical assistance recipients
OTHER REQUIREMENTS:	<p>The specialist will have a desire to participate in the development of Haiti. A valid passport is required o travel to Haiti. Must speak Creole and/or French</p>
DURATION OF ASSIGNMENT:	<p>One week (Leave for Haiti on Sunday and return home on the following Saturday). It should be noted that the specialist can choose to extend their stay in Haiti but at their own cost.</p>
