| ASSIGNMENT LOCATION: | Limbé, Montrouis |
| ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION: | <p>The specialist will work with established beekeeping cooperatives to develop business approaches to refining and marketing honey and other bee products; and also work with the organizations on their business model or efficiencies. S/he will assist the associations to improve their management including production and processing of honey. Areas of support to be provided are hive design, marketing, quality control, branding, processing, and association organization and governance. The objective of this assignment is to train beekeepers and beekeeping association leaders in the managerial aspects of successful honey processing, marketing, and enterprise business success.</p> |
| QUALIFICATIONS: | <p>The specialist is expected to have a demonstrated solid experience in the operation of beekeeping/honey production associations and/or cooperatives.</p> |
| OTHER REQUIREMENTS: | <p>Qualified persons are expected to be able to communicate with local Haitian partners in either Creole or French. Previous experience living and working in a developing country context is strongly desired. A valid passport is required for travel to Haiti.</p> |
| DURATION OF ASSIGNMENT: | <p>One week (Leave for Haiti on Sunday and return home on the following Saturday). The assignment may be extended to two weeks at the request of the specialist. It should be noted that the specialist can choose to extend their stay in Haiti but at their own cost.</p> |
