**POSITION DESCRIPTION**

<b>POSITION:</b> Marine Protected Area management specialist
<b>ASSIGNMENT LOCATION:</b> Montrouis
<b>ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION:</b> The expert will assess and evaluate the proposed marine protected area between the Arcadins coast and the Island of Gonave. The objective is to propose and map buffer zones on the coastal areas adjacent to the Arcadins MPA. The work will involve travel along the coastal areas and discussions with community groups and other stakeholders.
<b>QUALIFICATIONS:</b> The expert is expected to have solid experience in the collaborative management of marine protected areas including zoning arrangements and coastal zone management.
<b>OTHER REQUIREMENTS:</b> Qualified persons are expected to be able to communicate with local Haitian partners in either Creole or French. Previous experience living and working in a developing country context is strongly desired. A valid passport is required for travel to Haiti.
<b>DURATION OF ASSIGNMENT:</b> One week (Leave for Haiti on Sunday and return home on the following Saturday). The assignment may be extended to two weeks at the request of the specialist. It should be noted that the specialist can choose to extend their stay in Haiti but at their own cost.
